Why a Lions License Plate

1. Display your Lions pride.

3. Fund raising. Plate costs extra \$25 as a tax deductible charitable contribution. After development costs paid, the \$25 goes to Wisconsin Lions Foundation, e.g. 2,000 license plates raises \$50,000.00.

Thanks to all who made contact with Senate Transportation Committee members. They voted 5 to 1 in favor of Lions License Plate Bill, SB307, on Jan. 14, 2010. SB307 now goes to the full Senate.

NOW, THE ASSEMBLY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE VOTE ON THE LICENSE PLATE BILL AB465 IS SCHEDULED FOR THURS. JAN. 21, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. It is essential that every Assembly Transportation Committee member get numerous contacts with requests to support this Bill.

The Legislators' main question will be What does it cost the state? Answer: nothing; costs are paid from the first 948 plates sold. The Dept. of Transportation develops the plate and fills the orders. After 948 plates are sold the extra \$25 goes to Wisconsin Lions Foundation. This source of ongoing funding for the foundation will be invaluable over the years.
