Lions Foundation plate

Any Wisconsin resident may apply for Lions Foundation license plates. The Wisconsin Lions Foundation, Inc. (WLF) administers all statewide projects of the Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs of Wisconsin. Through these club donations, as well as support from many other donors, WLF is able to make a difference in the lives of thousands of people each year. Your donation works to support:

- ▶ Wisconsin Lions Camp—a free one-week summer camp experience for Wisconsin children and adults with disabilities. Campers are able to meet others who live with the same daily challenges as they do and enjoy summer camping geared towards their abilities. The camp provides a free week to approximately 1,400 people a summer.
- ▶ Eyeglass Recycling Center—collect used eyeglasses and wash, sort and ship them to third world countries to give those less fortunate the opportunity to see clearly. Over 800,000 pairs go through the Center annually.
- ▶ Hearing Aid Program—collect used hearing aids for credit to provide hearing aids to Wisconsin residents who cannot afford to buy a hearing aid.
- ▶ Diabetes Awareness—to raise awareness, hold free screenings and educate the public regarding the dangers of this disease, signs and symptoms and management techniques.

Who is eligible?

- ▶ Any Wisconsin resident.

Lions Foundation plates are available for:

- ▶ Automobiles
- ▶ Motor homes (Annual registration only);
- ▶ A private truck, dual purpose motor home or dual purpose farm truck that has a gross weight of 8,000 pounds or less;
- ▶ A farm truck that has a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less.

General information

Fees needed

- ▶ A **\$25.00 annual** donation to the Lions Foundation. The donation may be tax deductible if you itemize your income tax returns.
- ▶ A \$15.00 issuance fee **or** an annual \$15.00 personalized plate fee;
- ▶ The annual registration fee, if your current plates expire within 3 months.

Plates required in 2 days

- ▶ To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within two business days of purchase.
- ▶ If you do not have current plates, apply to a DMV Customer Service Center or an agent authorized by DMV to obtain a temporary plate while your Lions Foundation plate order is processed. An agent may charge a plate fee and/or service fee.

Personalized plate information

Personalizing your Lions Foundation plates is optional.

- ▶ A \$15.00 personalized plate fee is required every year in addition to the \$25.00 donation and regular registration fee.
- ▶ Your personalized plate choice may not be available. **See “note” on the application (page 3) and complete.**
- ▶ WisDOT may refuse to issue or recall after issuance, a request that is misleading or may be offensive to good taste or decency.
- ▶ No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after the plate has been ordered, or if the application is unclear or incorrectly completed.
- ▶ After the Certificate of Registration is issued, allow 4–6 weeks for the manufacturing and mailing process before the plates arrive.

HOW TO APPLY

1. To order non-personalized Lions Foundation plates, mark first option and go to step 5 below.
2. To order personalized Lions Foundation plates, mark second option and choose 1-6 characters. If you choose 6 characters, no spaces are allowed.

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If you choose 5 or fewer characters, you may request up to two spaces between any of the characters. Indicate a space with a diagonal line as shown here.

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3. Use capital letters or numbers. The letter O and the number zero are the same. The following are not acceptable: small letters, symbols, signs, hyphens, apostrophes, etc. Carefully distinguish between: letters L or I and number 1, letter S and number 5, letter G and number 6, letter Z and number 2, letter B and number 8, letters U and V.
4. Provide meaning of request, i.e., what does this represent?
5. If the vehicle that you wish to register with Lions Foundation plates is already titled in your name, send:
 - » A copy of your Certificate of Registration **or** complete the vehicle description on the application;
 - » \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee, plus the annual registration fee if the current plates expire within the next 3 months;
 - » \$25 Lions Foundation annual donation.
6. If the vehicle is **not** titled in your name, send:
 - » The title assigned to you;
 - » A completed title application: [MV1](#) (Private Sale) or MV11 (Dealer Sale);
 - » All required fees, including annual registration fee;
 - » Additional \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee;
 - » \$25 Lions Foundation annual donation.
